Requirements:

Students will be expected to provide documentation for the following requirements to be considered for induction in the spring of 2019:

1. Character:

- Involvement in Extracurricular and Community activities
Examples: clubs, teams, music/theater groups, church, scouts, 4-H,
- 3 Adult Signatures recommending the student are required with letter of application in April/May
- No behavior issues (DR's)

2. Leadership:

- Evidence of Leadership positions held in school, community, or work activities

3. Service & Citizenship Activities

- Done FOR or ON BEHALF OF OTHERS for which no compensation is given
- 10 hours of approved service total to MMS and/or community
(3 hours minimum at school)
- Regular attendance at NJHS meetings

4. Academic Achievement/Scholarship

- Maintains proficiency levels of 2.5 and above in 4 Core Subjects
- As evidenced by Term 1,2, and 3 report card scores in the 4 Core Subjects
(Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies)

5. Selection:

- Student submits letter in late April or early May:
- Includes why you participated in NJHS, describe how you met the four requirements listed above.
- Includes: How did your participation in NJHS benefit others?
- Includes: 3 Adult signatures supporting your membership
- Selection committee consists of 5 MMS staff members
